Babies of Yellowstone National Park:

April 22, 2018 Load at 6:00 AM

Heart Mountain Interpretive Center

Buffalo Bill Center of the West

June 17, 2018 Load at 8:00 AM



Heart Mountain-The Center provides an overview of the wartime relocations of Japanese Americans during WWII, including the background history of anti-Asian prejudice in America and the factors leading to their enforced relocation and confinement.

Buffalo Bill Center- Take your choice of Museums during our stay from, the Cody Firearms, Draper Natural History Museum, to the Plains Indian or the Whitney Western Art Museum. So much to see.

The cost is just \$35.00 and includes your travel and entrance costs to the Museums and Interpretive Center. Bring your picnic lunch or use the Café at the Buffalo Bill Center. We will be stopping at the Historic Irma Hotel for dinner (not included) and catching the shootout. 30 minimum maximum is 58.

**Little Bighorn Battlefield
Big Horn County Historical Museum
July 29, 2018 Load at 7:00 AM**

Better known as Custer's Last Stand, this sacred area is memorializes the fight between the Sioux, Cheyenne and the US Cavalry. Spend some time learning all sides of this historic event. After the visit we will move to the Big Horn County Historical Museum and walk through the buildings that gives a glimpse of the past.



The cost is \$25.00 and includes your travel and entrance costs to the Battlefield and Museum. You will need a picnic lunch and we will stop for dinner on our way back home. Minimum- 58 maximum.
