Answer the 2 questions in blue boxes

Have you been notified by the public health department that you are a contact of an individual who tested positive for COVID-19?

Are you unwell with fever, flu/cold or unexplained symptoms (i.e.: sore throat, persistent cough, difficulty breathing, headache, chills, loss of taste/smell, significant muscle pain/aches, diarrhea)?

****If you tests + for COVID-19, Follow the instructions from public health department and the same 3 underlined criteria listed in yellow box needs to be met before returning to work.**

Have you been fever free without medication for 72 hours? Were you seen your doctor and diagnosed with something other than COVID-19?

-Clearance, note by a health care provider is preferred upon return to work

RiverStone Health's free drive through COVID-19 testing Shrine Auditorium
1125 Broadwater Ave Testing is open for people with COVID-19 symptoms and identified close contacts of people who are positive for COVID Monday through Friday from 9am to 12:30pm or until the daily allotment of tests have concluded. People who are tested will remain in their vehicles.

If you have a fever or other symptoms that could be from COVID-19 and do not get tested OR are not cleared by your doctor, it is assumed you have COVID-19 and may not return to work until **ALL 3 following criteria are met:**

1. At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared or if asymptomatic, 10 days since positive test result
2. Marked improvement of symptoms
3. At least 24 hrs have passed since recovery (No fever without the use of medication)
